




Pakistan Age Pyramid





Population of Four Provinces and Islamabad







Punjab Age Pyramid




Punjab Growth Rate



Punjab Urban / Rural Population








Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Demographic Profile



Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Age Pyramid






Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Growth Rate



Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Urban / Rural Population in Millions








Sindh Age Pyramid




Sindh Growth Rate



Sindh Urban / Rural Population in Millions











Balochistan Age Pyramid




Balochistan Growth Rate

in Millions








