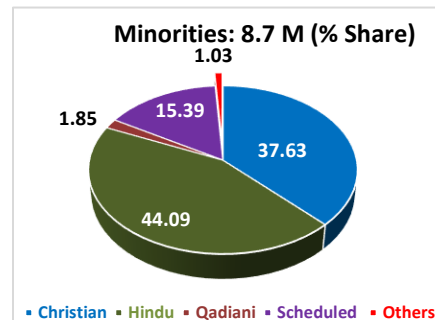
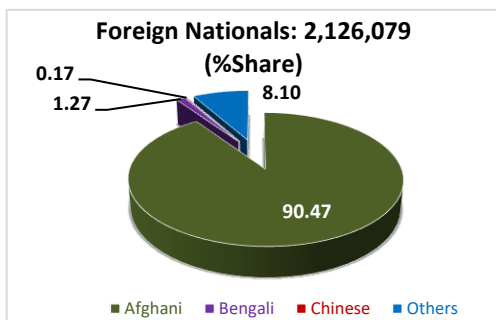
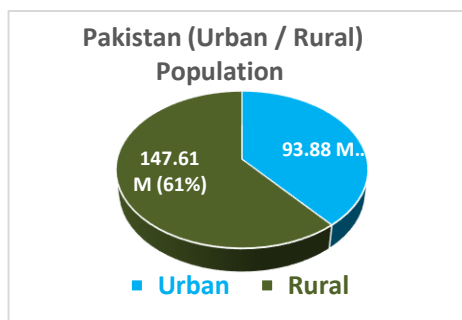


Pakistan Age Pyramid

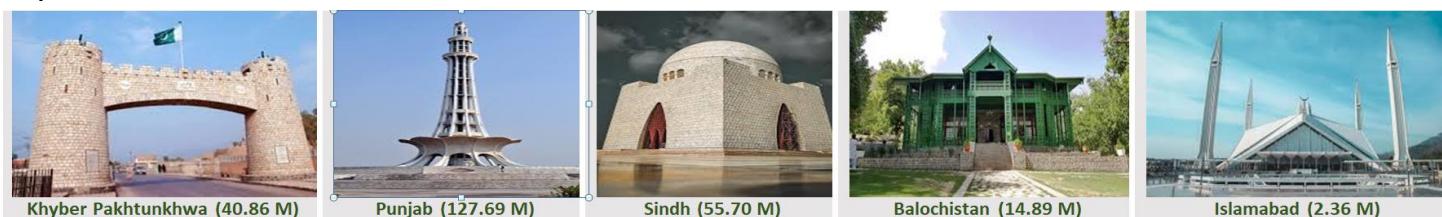

OUT OF SCHOOL CHILDREN (IN PERCENTAGE)



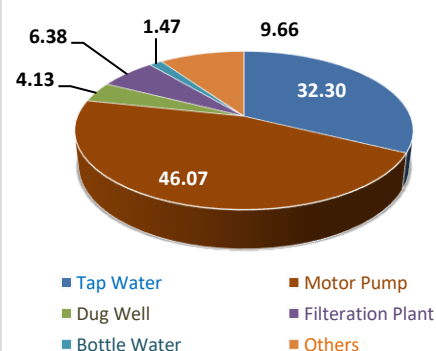

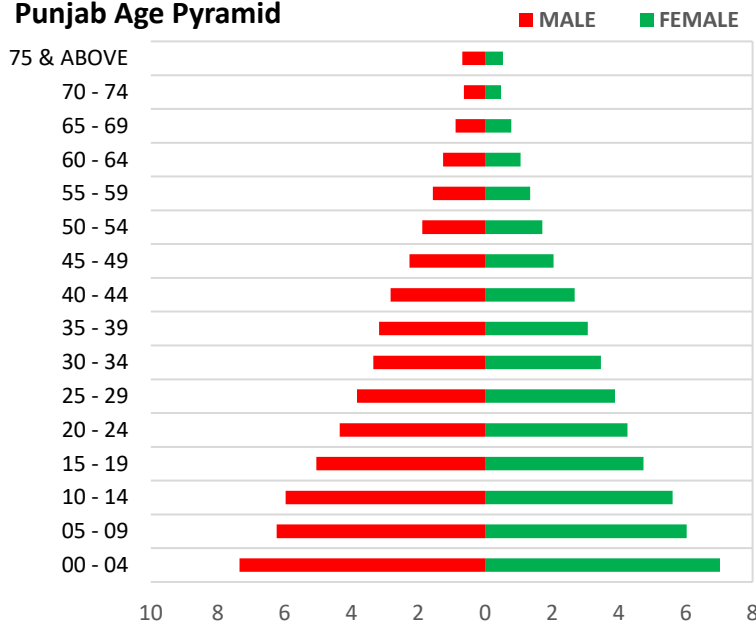

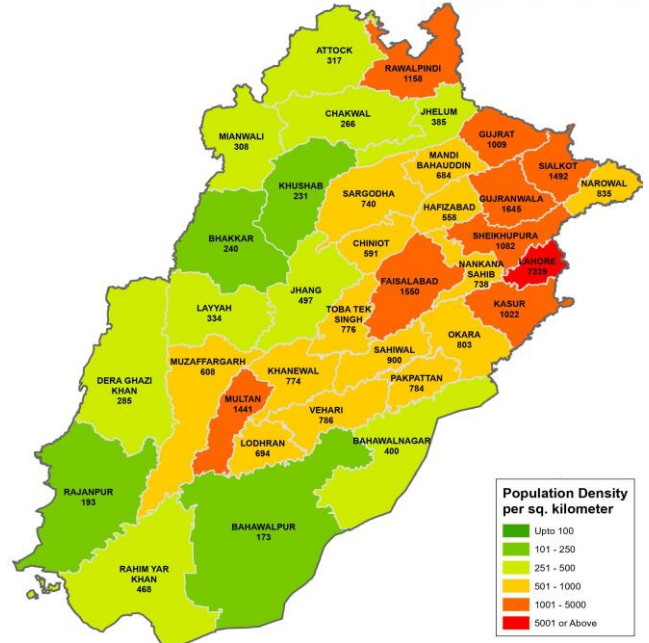

Punjab Age Pyramid

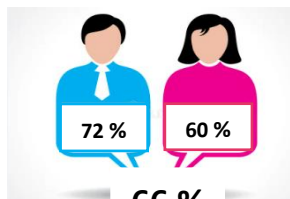

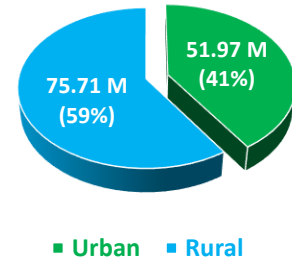

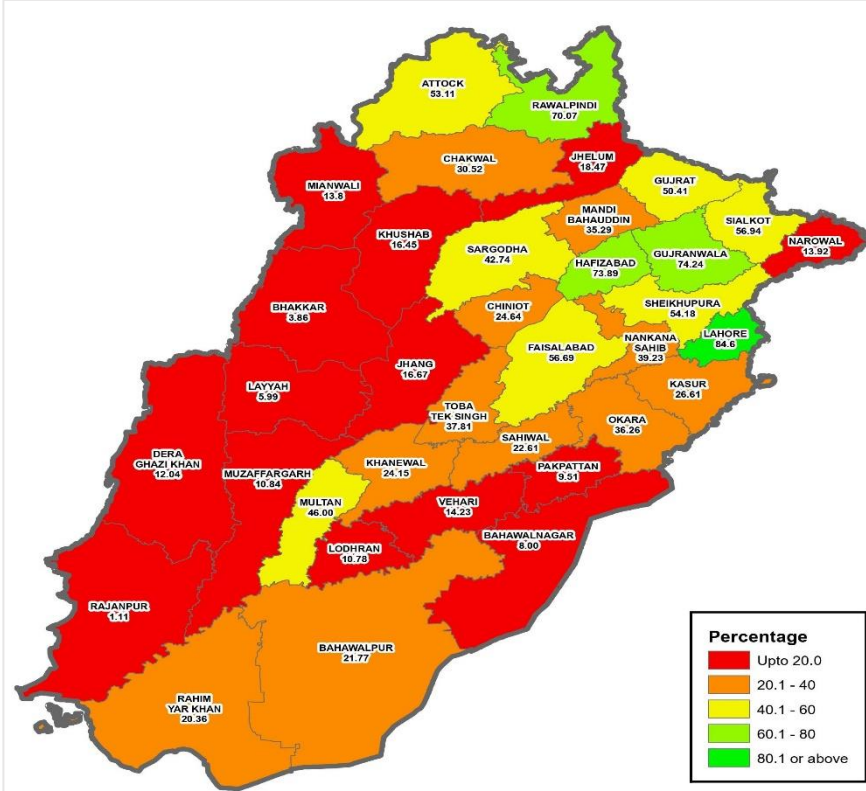
Punjab Growth Rate

in Millions



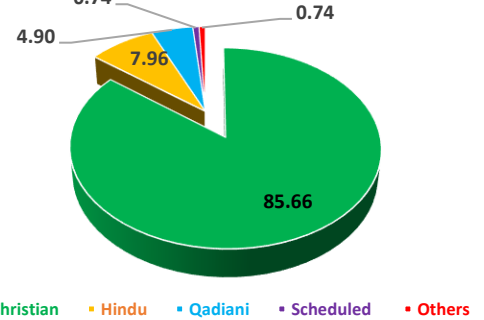

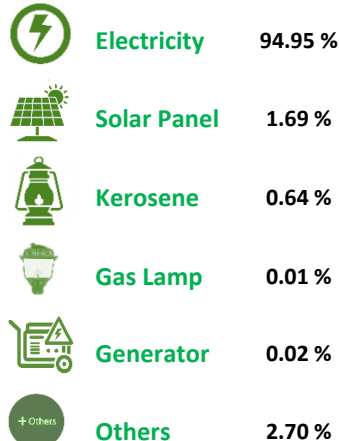

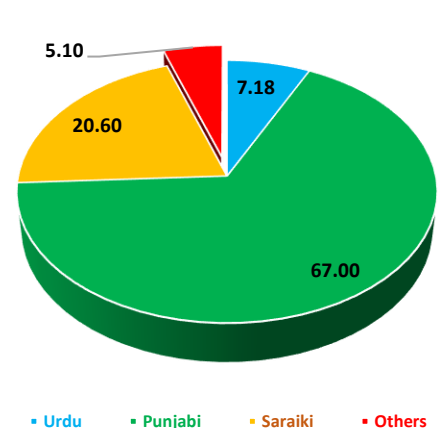
Drinking Water (In Percentage)

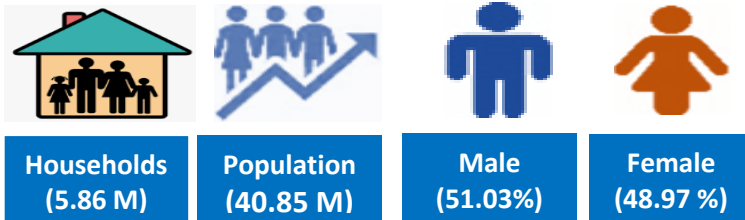

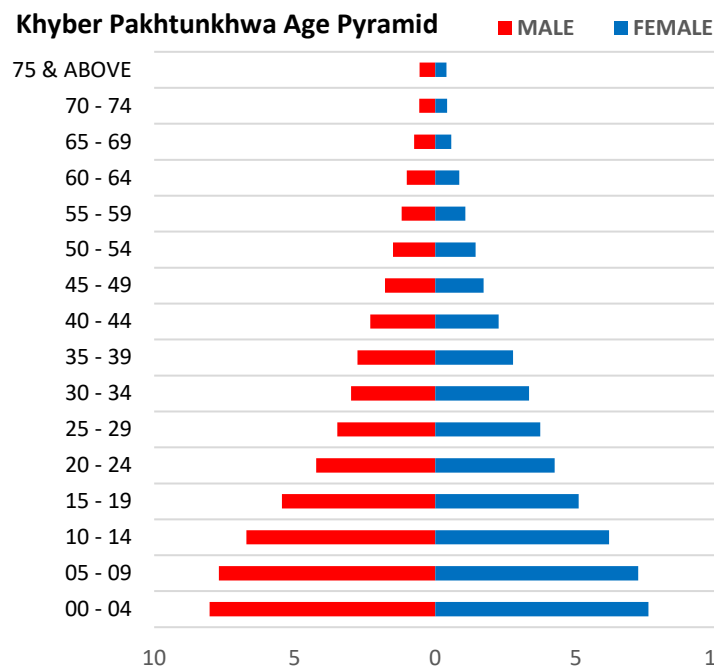

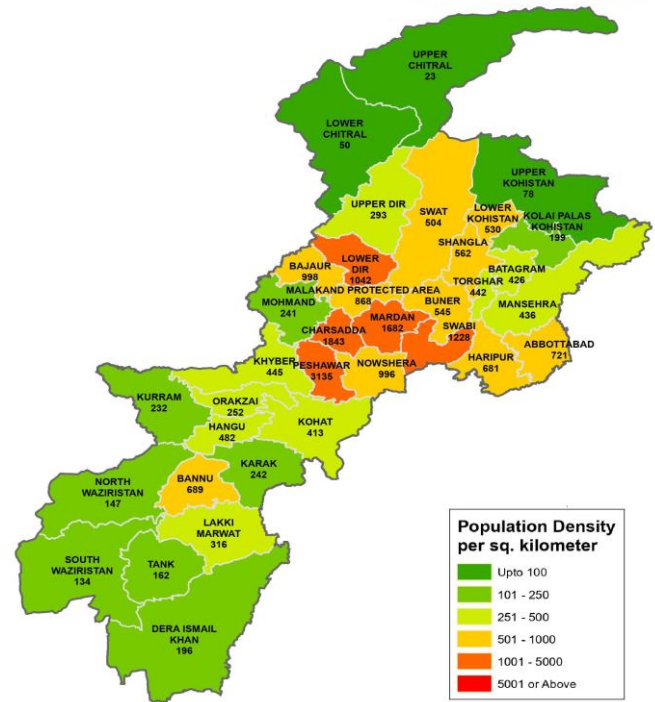
Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Demographic Profile



Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Age Pyramid

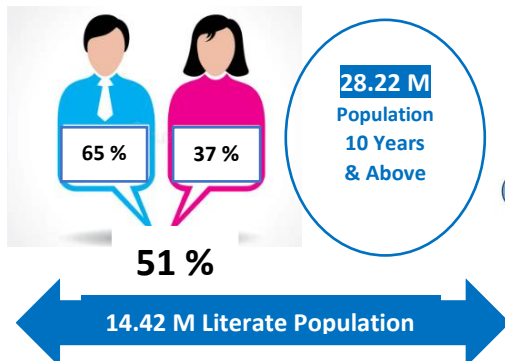

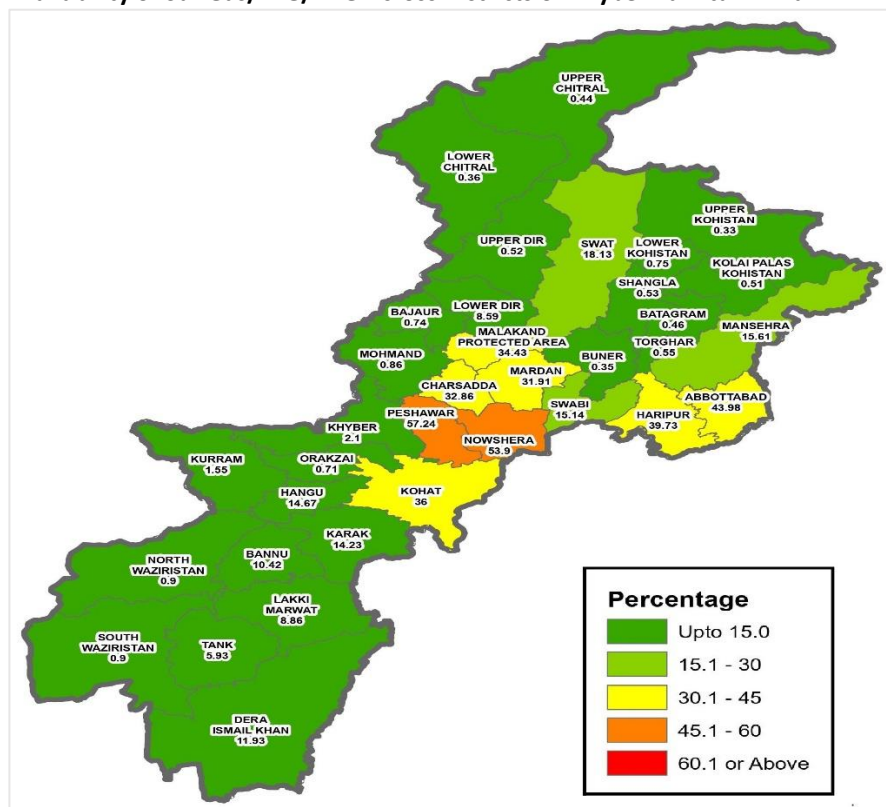
Largest Districts of KPK in terms of Population

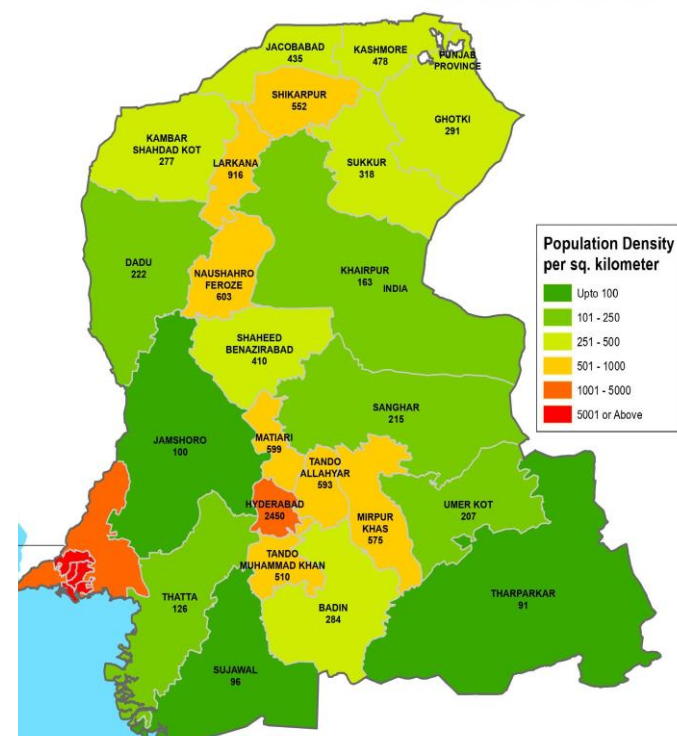
Sindh Demographic Profile

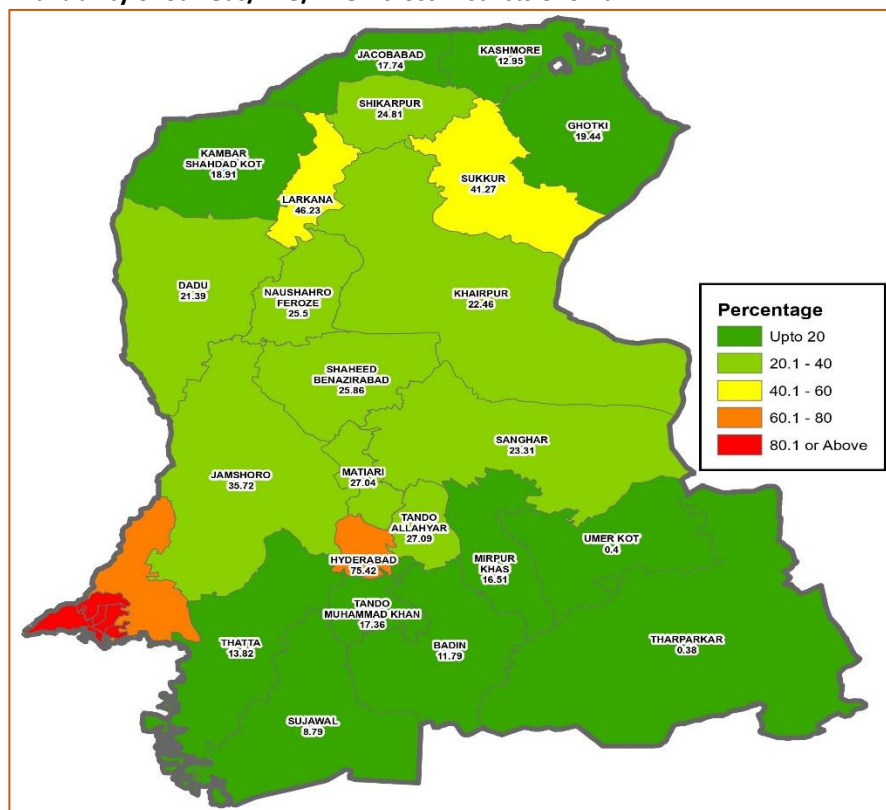
Largest Cities of Sindh in terms of Population

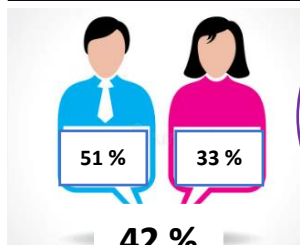
